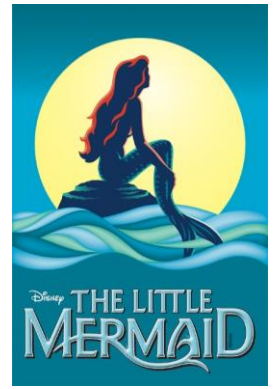




A Few Words on Auditioning



- Think of your audition as a performance, not just an audition.
- Don't hold back. We want to see your energy. We understand that you are nervous, we have all auditioned before. If you allow your nerves to get the better of you it will only hurt you.
- We are not here to criticize you. We want you to succeed.
- We may stop you during an audition and give you directions. We want to see how well you can take those directions and process them.
- We may ask you to read/sing/dance for a part other than what you indicated during your registration. Approach this with the same energy and positive attitude that you would bring to any part. We may see something in you that you don't that would make you right for another part.
- If we stop your performance don't take this as an indication of anything. This just means that we have seen all that we need to see. It is not a bad thing.
- Most importantly, have fun with this process. Your enthusiasm will show and will carry you a long way.
