

George Abud is hugely proud of the work and the magic that exists within this production. He is indebted to his wonderful collaborators, Isabella Pacifico for her commitment to making every piece of this show singularly special and thrilling to watch. Olivia Ferguson for her consistently beautiful artistry and unending generosity. Emma Harrison for her incredible contributions to each step of the process. Ann Knepp whose love and artistry has truly brought this show vividly to life, and James Pecar for his superior leadership and unwavering devotion to making this show come together for every participant. He also wishes to thank Shawn Polito, Roger Harrison, and Josh Bacarella who have created the exceptional set and the most wondrous world for the show to live in. The true glory of this production lies in the passionate and tremendously talented young performers who have put so much of themselves into making this experience uniquely special and incredible. By bringing so much of their hearts and spirits to the stage each day they have been able to create a Seussical that is undeniably special and endlessly inspiring.

Mr. Abud is the recipient of a Daytime Emmy Award for his work on NBC's "Today Show" with the Broadway Production of THE BAND'S VISIT. For his role as Nerd Face in the new musical EMOJILAND he received a Drama Desk Award Nomination for Outstanding Featured Actor in a Musical, as well as appearing on its Original Off-Broadway Cast Recording. On Broadway he has originated roles in the Tony-Award Winning Musical THE BAND'S VISIT starring Katrina Lenk & Tony Shalhoub, and on its Original Broadway Cast Recording; as well as Kander & Ebb's final musical THE VISIT starring Chita Rivera & Roger Rees, and its OBC Recording. Off-Broadway Mr. Abud has created roles in THE RESISTIBLE RISE OF ARTURO UI opposite 4-Time Tony Award Nominee Raul Esparza, in NATHAN THE WISE opposite Academy Award Winner F. Murray Abraham, in PEER GYNT alongside Tony Award Winner Gabriel Ebert, and in Rodgers and Hammerstein's ALLEGRO directed by Tony Award Winner John Doyle, all for New York's Classic Stage Company; also, the world-premiere of THE BAND'S VISIT directed by Tony Award Winner David Cromer at the Atlantic Theater Company, and LOLITA, MY LOVE opposite Robert Sella at the York Theatre Company. Recently, Mr. Abud starred as Lewis Chapman in the original musical adaptation of AUGUST RUSH at the Paramount Theatre outside of Chicago; as Charlie Davenport in ANNIE GET YOUR GUN directed by Sarna Lapine at the Bay Street Theater; and as Puck in A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM at Geva Theatre Center. Internationally, he starred opposite Broadway greats Barbara Walsh, Marc Kudisch, and Paulo Szot in the world premiere political opera THE NEW PRINCE at the Dutch National Opera in Amsterdam.

Mr. Abud was born and raised in Michigan, and received his formal training in theatre at Wayne State University and the Moscow Art Theatre in Russia. He currently lives in New York City with his wife, Erica, and has been working in the professional theatre for the past decade.

Lynn Ahrens won Tony, Drama Desk and Outer Critics Circle Awards and received two Grammy nominations for Broadway's Ragtime. For Twentieth Century Fox's animated feature film Anastasia, she was nominated for two Academy Awards and two Golden Globes. She and longtime collaborator Stephen Flaherty received the Oscar Hammerstein Award for Lifetime Achievement, and in 2015 they were inducted into the Theater Hall of Fame. Broadway: Anastasia; Once On This Island (Olivier Award, Best Musical; Tony nominations, Best Book and Score); Seussical (Grammy nomination); My Favorite Year; Chita Rivera: The Dancer's Life; Rocky; Madison Square Garden's A Christmas Carol; Ragtime (2010 Broadway revival). Off-Broadway and regional: Lincoln Center Theater's Dessa Rose, The Glorious Ones (both Drama Desk-nominated) and A Man of No Importance (Outer Critics Circle Award, Best Musical): Lucky Stiff; Little Dancer (Kennedy Center world premiere). Film and television credits include "A Christmas Carol" (NBC-TV); Camp (IFC Films); "Schoolhouse Rock" (ABC-TV) and others. (Emmy Award and four Emmy nominations). Stephen Flaherty is the composer of the Broadway musicals Ragtime (Tony, Drama Desk, OCC Awards, two Grammy nominations), Seussical (Grammy, Drama Desk nominations), Once on This Island (Tony nomination, Olivier Award, Best Musical) and Rocky. Additional Broadway includes Chita Rivera: The Dancer's Life (original songs) and Neil Simon's Proposals (incidental music). Stephen has also written four musicals at Lincoln Center Theatre: The Glorious Ones (OCC, Drama Desk nominations), Dessa Rose (OCC, Drama Desk nominations), A Man of No Importance (OCC, Best Musical, Drama Desk nomination) and My Favorite Year. Other theater includes In Your Arms (Old Globe), Little Dancer (Kennedy Center), Lucky Stiff (Playwrights Horizons) and Loving Repeating: A Musical of Gertrude Stein (Chicago's Jefferson Award, Best New Musical.) Film includes Anastasia (two Academy Award and two Golden Globe nominations), the documentary After The Storm and Lucky Stiff. Mr. Flaherty's concert music has premiered at the Hollywood Bowl, Boston's Symphony Hall, Carnegie Hall, the Guggenheim Museum and Symphony Space. This year celebrates Stephen's 32-year collaboration with lyricist-librettist Lynn Ahrens. Stephen and Lynn are members of the Dramatists Guild Council and co-founders of the Dramatists Guild Fellows Program. In 2015 they were inducted into the Theater Hall Of Fame. Eric Idle has multi-hyphenated his way through life assiduously avoiding a proper job, from a writer and actor in the legendary "Monty Python" TV series and movies, to the creator and director of "The Rutles," the pre-fab four, whose legend will last a lunchtime. He has appeared on stage in drag singing rude songs at Carnegie Hall and the Hollywood Bowl as well as performing in two highly successful tours, Eric Idle Exploits Monty Python (2000) and The Greedy Bastard Tour (2003), for which he journeyed 15,000 miles across North America in a bus. HIS GREEDY BASTARD DIARY of that tour is published by Harper Collins. 
McKenna Mead




